In it participants take on the role of medieval Japanese samurai. It is played with a minimum of special equipment and a maximum of personal commitment and integrity. The game requires no significant amount of physical contact, but it does ask each participant to fully engage with others and become aware of the interplay of thought, action and consequence. From this perspective individuals and teams at every level can reframe past experiences and gain sharp new awareness about their customary behavior patterns. Thus the game becomes a mirror for how one lives life, at home and at work.

As a result of your participation you will increase your ability to:

- Coordinate and blend with others in personal and professional interaction
- Manifest bold, dignified and decisive action in the face of uncertainty
- Listen deeply to and be clearly heard by others
- Evoke respectful and honorable behaviour from self and others
- Maintain a strong sense of balance between gain and loss
- Effectively lead and follow – at work and at home
